

## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY—INDEPENDENT ENTRY TO SCHOOLS CATEGORY

Schools Category artists must be enrolled as a full time student.

Registrations must be received at [art@ardrossan.sa.au](mailto:art@ardrossan.sa.au) by Friday, 13th March 2026.

Artwork must be original, with ideas developed, created and completed by the artist. Artist name, title of artwork, medium and possible sale price must be displayed clearly on the back of the artwork. Artists are responsible for checking their entries against our listings when delivering artwork.

A photograph of the artwork must be included when registering.

Artwork will be received at Ardrossan Town Hall on Sunday, 29th 1-3pm or Monday, 30th March 4-5pm. Unsold artwork can be collected from Ardrossan Town Hall on Sunday, 5th April 10-12pm.

We require Fine Art and Photography entries to be framed and prepared to hang.

Sculptures need to be free standing or presented on a stand.

Schools Category Artists are limited to entering 2 artworks in total. This includes artworks submitted by the individual and by the school.

Entries must not exceed 1.5m x 1.5m.

Artwork must have been created in the last 2 years and not have been previously displayed for sale on the Yorke Peninsula.

Artwork can be available for sale, but this is not compulsory in the Schools Category.

Ardrossan Progress Association will collect a 10% commission from all sales.

The artist indemnifies Ardrossan Progress Association and 2026 Ardrossan Art Display working party against any claim, loss and damage of any nature or cause relating to entered artworks.

The Ardrossan Progress Association reserves the right to refuse to display any artworks.

## JUDGING CRITERIA

Creativity and Originality—evidence of imagination, creativity and individuality.

Technique—media and tools have been chosen and utilised competently to enhance the appearance of the work.

Organisation—elements and principles of art are used effectively and selectively to enhance the appearance of the work.

Clarity of theme—artworks combine technique, expression and organisation through artistic and critical judgement.

Presentation—the presentation is in accordance with the style of the art piece.

The judges' decision is final—no discussion will be entered into.

The judges reserve the right not to award a prize in any category if, in their belief, the work is not of a worthy standard for a prize.
